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Required text: Robin/Evans-Romaine/Shatalina/Robin Golosa, Book 2, 3d edition. We will use the textbook and the workbook in class. All additional materials are on the Internet.

Course description: This course will continue the basics of Russian grammar while emphasizing the acquisition of reading, listening, and speaking skills by the student.

Prerequisites: Rus-111 or Rus-101 and Rus-102

Goals: Students will finish the basics of the Russian case and verb systems and achieve active use of the language at an intermediate level.

Requirements: There will be a departmental exam after each unit. There will be no make-up exams except in very rare circumstances.

Final exam: May 6, 2004 8:00-10:30
